Fair Trading Act 1973 an Act which consolidated and extended UK competition law by controlling MONOPOLIES, MERGERS AND TAKEOVERS, RESTRICTIVE TRADE AGREEMENTS and RESALE PRICES. The Act established a new regulatory authority the OFFICE OF FAIR TRADING (headed by the Director-General of Fair Trading) with powers to supervise all aspects of COMPETITION POLICY, including the monitoring of changes ...

The Consumer Protection Act

This Bill significantly increased the protections for consumers and specifically included sections for: Ticket Sales and Re-sales, Automotive Sales and Repairs, High-Cost Credit, Veterinary Medicine, and arbitrations/court. In addition, this Bill changed the name of the Fair Trading Act to the Consumer Protection Act.
